- Always wash hands and change clothing after handling chemicals.
- Follow application guidelines to avoid overuse, which can harm crops and nearby ecosystems.

- Farmers have suffered chemical burns from improperly handled fertilizer.
- Runoff from excessive fertilizer use has led to water pollution issues in Wisconsin.
