

Skid Steer & Loader Operation Safety

Key Safety Points:

- Pre-operation Checks: Always perform a thorough inspection of the skid steer or loader before use. Check tires, fluids, hydraulic systems, and safety features.
- Operator Training: Only trained and authorized personnel should operate heavy machinery. Understand the controls, limits, and handling of the equipment.
- Mounting & Dismounting: Always maintain three points of contact when entering or exiting the machine. This helps to prevent slips, trips, and falls.
- Load Handling: Ensure the load is properly secured and within the machine's capacity. Overloading can cause the equipment to tip or malfunction.
- Visibility: Make sure your work area is clear of obstacles. Always use the equipment's horn to alert others when operating in congested areas.
- Safety Gear: Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE), including a hard hat, safety boots, and gloves.
